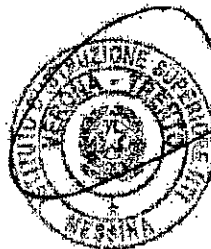

- 1) **CURRENCY** – in Zagreb you can pay in **Croatian currency KUNA** (1 EUR = cca 7,5 HRK), or you can use any debit or credit card.
 Exchange offices are at every corner of the major tourist points in the city centre.

Please use your time in Zagreb before the official programme to exchange your cash money, for the programme expenses.

- 2) **PUBLIC TRANSPORT:** you will use the public transport often (buses or trams)

One way ticket (30 min): 4 HRK
 One way ticket (1 h): 7 HRK
 One way ticket (90 min): 10 HRK
 Daily ticket: 30 HRK
 7 day ticket: 150, 00 HRK

You can BUY the tickets AT EVERY NEWSSTAND. Ticket needs to be validated at the machine – on the front of the bus/tram, and in the back.

Croatian students like to try and pass without paying, but there are regular controls on the trams and buses, so I advise to regularly validate your tickets.

I suggest you purchase 10 30-min tickets at once (total of 40 HRK) and see how much you use during the day, but it is up to you. Every excursion will be up to 30 min ride.

- 3) **LUNCHES DO NOT INCLUDE DRINKS** – each person orders and pays for their drinks. Croatian students **NO MATTER** their age (18 and above) are not allowed to drink alcohol during school trips. I expect that Italian students respect our rule and also don't order any alcohol.
